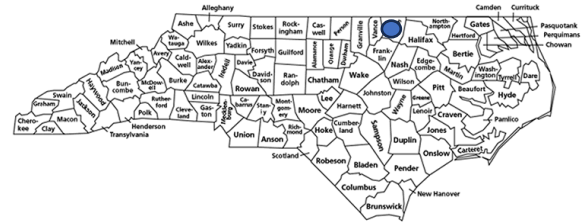

Among six age groups – 0 to 4, 5 to 19, 20 to 34, 35 to 49, 50 to 64, and 65 and older – the **65+** group was the fastest growing between **2010** and **2022**, with its population increasing by **28.3%**. The **50 to 64** age group **declined the most, dropping 18.6%** between **2010** and **2022**.

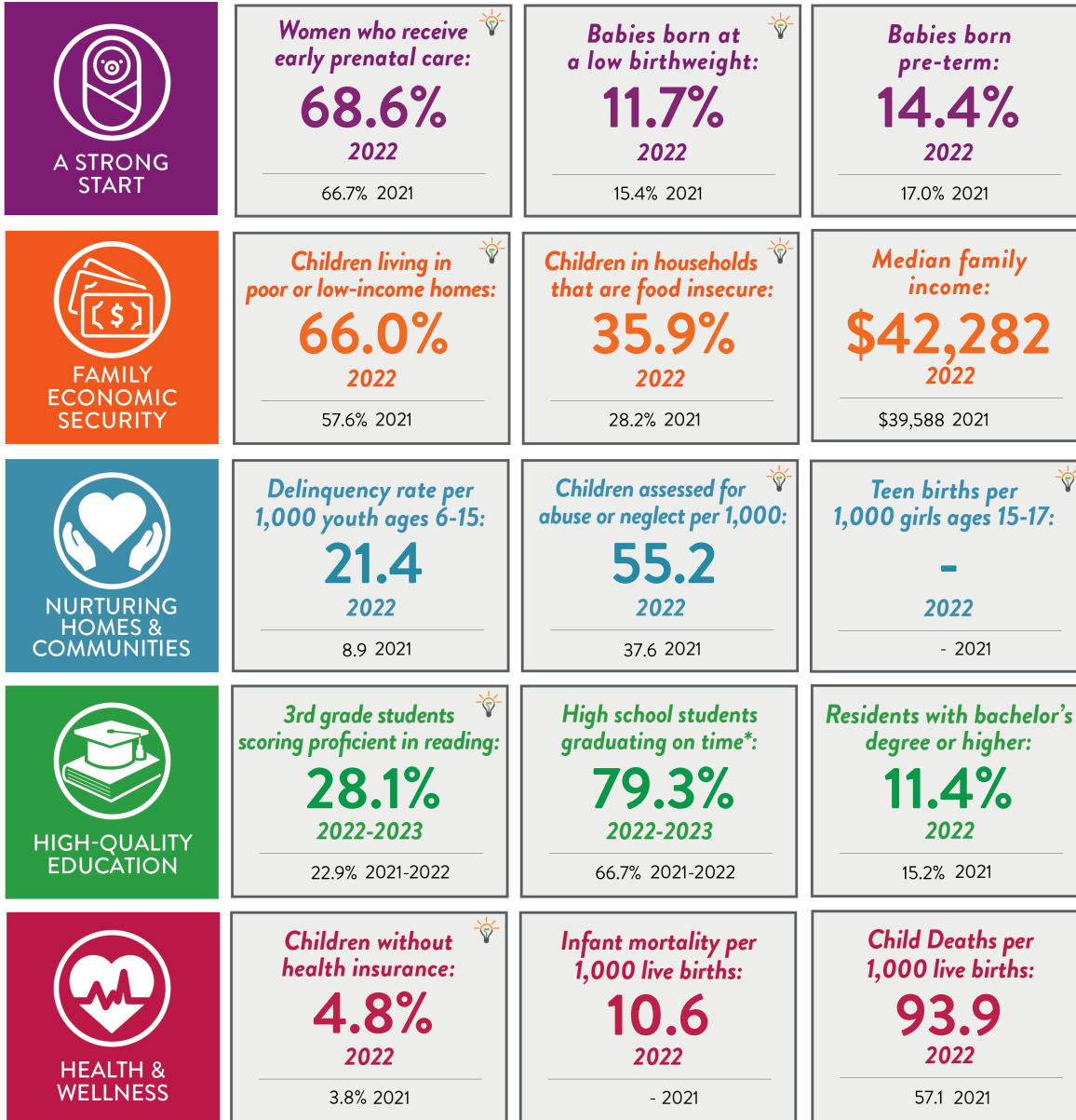

# Warren County

Warren County has a population of 19,500, a decrease of 7% over the past decade.  
North Carolina's population increased 10% over the past decade.

## North Carolina needs to invest in ...



### Expanding Access to Health Services

- 13% of people do not have health insurance.
- Life expectancy for white newborns is 80 years, compared to 77 years for Black newborns.
- There is one mental health provider for every 1,790 residents.



### Making Sure Everyone Can Make Ends Meet

- There are 78 candidates for every job opening. <sup>††</sup>
- Rent is unaffordable for 44% of renters.
- Median worker earnings are 78% of what it takes for a family of 1 adult and 2 children to make ends meet.



### Removing Structural Barriers to Equity

- 43% of residents are considered low-income (less than \$51,500 for a family of four). <sup>\*\*</sup>
- The richest 5% of households make an average of 31 times more than the poorest 20% of households.

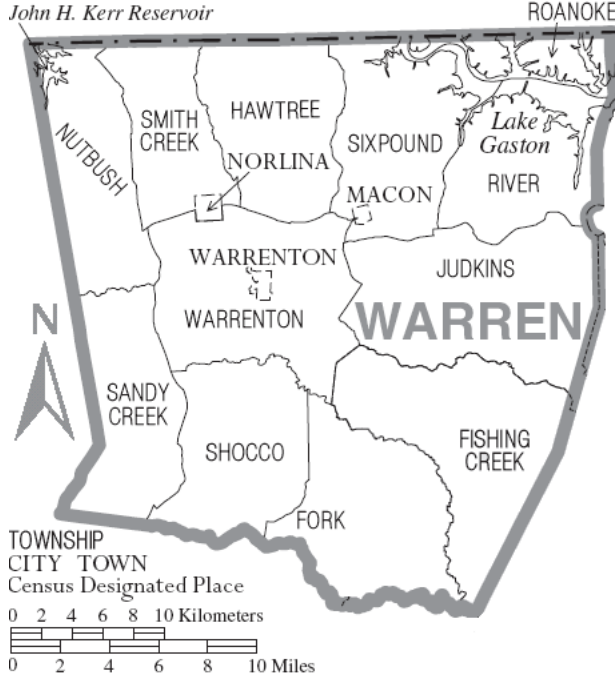

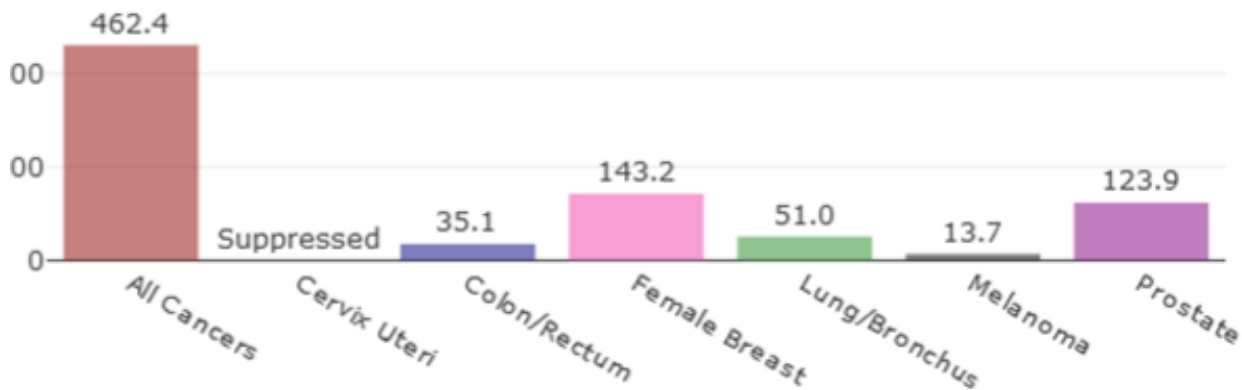

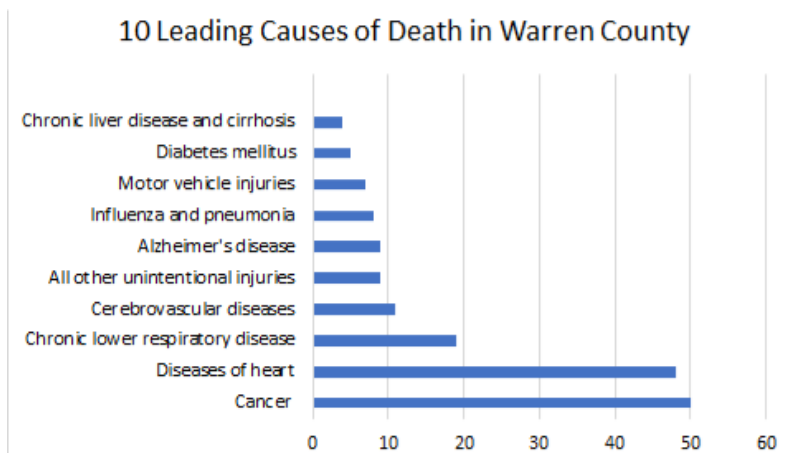
